Last year I was exhibiting my horse paintings at an art show when I happened to meet a very accomplished artist. He was from Siberia. Since I had never before met someone from Siberia, I was fascinated by his story of growing up in the Russian countryside. At the end of our conversation, he unexpectedly said to me, "Your work is so American. It is all about freedom." In two sentences he had summed up my entire vision as an artist. For me, it was the ultimate compliment."

Nancy's work has been published in Equine Vision, Western Horseman, Western Art Collector and most recently Art of the West magazines. Exhibition venues include the Redding Museum and Art Center, the Ronald Reagan Presidential Museum and Library, the Tucson Museum of Art, the International Museum of the Horse in Kentucky, the Desert Caballeros Western Museum in Arizona and the Cheyenne Frontier Days Old West Museum in Wyoming.
